



# BOCA HOUSE/AWAKENINGS

## “A Clean and Sober Community for Men and Women”

Boca House for men and Awakenings for women are two separate recovery communities that share the same goal: They provide a safe environment for men and women who are early in recovery, so they can begin to learn to live a life that is drug/alcohol free.

What you can expect from us is:

- Dedicated staff available day, night and weekends
- Client financial management
- Medication safekeeping
- Van service to transport clients arriving at airports, train and bus stations
- Transportation provided daily for the first 3 weeks to AA/NA meetings
- Nightly life skill workshops
- Random urine screens to ensure a drug free community

What we expect from you:

- Remain abstinent from drugs and alcohol
- Submit to random urine test performed on site
- Follow all community rules
- Be on the property prior to curfew
- Maintain employment
- Attend daily 12-step meetings (90 meetings / 90 days)
- Find a sponsor
- Participate in weekly life-skills workshops
- Pay weekly rent in a timely manner
- Refrain from any inappropriate behavior such as gambling, sexual misconduct and attending clubs, bars and events where drugs/alcohol is being provided.

The following are the necessary finances that are needed for entry into Boca House/Awakenings:

- \$300.00 Deposit
  - o \$250.00 of the deposit money will be refunded to resident at the end of his/her six month commitment or longer. \$50.00 is used for administrative fees.
- \$320.00 Rent
  - o \$160.00 for the first weeks rent and \$160.00 for the last weeks rent of their commitment.

- \$200.00 or \$250.00 Client Cash
- o To be dispensed to the resident at \$20.00 per day.

TOTAL: \$820.00

We recommend that an extra week's rent be paid in advance to allow the time usually taken for residents to get a first paycheck from their job.

TOTAL: \$820.00 + \$160.00 = \$980.00

Therapy is also available at a rate of \$60.00 per individual session.

Finances can be paid by:

1. Credit Card (MasterCard or Visa accepted)
2. Postal Money Order
3. Certified or Bank Check
4. Western Union
5. Wire Transfer

In order to attain residency at Boca House/Awakenings, it is necessary to be clean of any drugs or alcohol upon admission. It has been our experience that if we don't remind our prospective residents of this fact, then about twenty percent of them arrive and do not pass the drug and alcohol test.

As we all know, recovery continues even after leaving a rehab center, and negative action begets consequences that will not be favorable to new residents and his/her family.

In order to avoid the unpleasant consequences of a relapse, we are taking this opportunity to give clarity to our prospective residents by informing them, in writing, of our policy. We want to make sure that there aren't any misunderstandings.

### Guidelines & Expectations

All tenants will be urine screened upon admission. If on admission, the tenant's urine screen comes up positive, he or she has the option of going into a detox, a treatment program (the tenant is responsible for payment of the detox and/or treatment program costs), or leaving the premises and returning home. If the tenant chooses to return home, he/she forfeits their security deposit.

While a tenant at Boca House/Awakenings, the use of alcohol and any mood-altering substances will result in immediate termination of residency. Tenants may be allowed to come back to Boca House/Awakenings only after agreeing to;

- First relapse: complete a detox
- Second relapse: complete a detox, if needed, and a day treatment program
- Third relapse: complete a detox, if needed, and a residential treatment program

Each time a tenant relapses, he/she is immediately discharged and their security deposit as well as last week's rent is forfeited. Upon return, their last week's rent is reinstated.

The tenant is responsible for payment of all treatment services.

Cost of treatment is as follows:

- Detox: \$400 a day (length of stay depends on the substance used)
- Day Treatment: \$250 a day (general length of stay is 3 to 4 weeks)
- Residential Treatment: \$5000 - \$10,000 (28 day stay)

The detox and treatment programs we work with accept most major insurances. If the tenant does not have insurance, then payment for treatment can be made using a credit card. Payment arrangements must be made prior to admission for treatment.

Treatment options are also available for those tenants who are interested in attending an aftercare program.
